



Introducing Olam Tikvah's: NEW High Holy Day Youth Services

This year Olam Tikvah is proud to offer families a series of age-appropriate worship opportunities designed for children from 18 months-6th grade!

These programs will be held on the first and second days of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur morning.

Children 18 Months to 3-years-old and Their Parents

The service will be led by Nechama Retting and will be held in Room 4 in the Youth Wing from 11:00-11:30am. Babysitting, for those who have pre-registered, will be available before and after the service.*

Children in PreK and K

The service will be led by Nechama Retting and will be held in Room 4 in the Youth Wing from 10:30-11:00am. Babysitting, for those who have pre-registered, will be available before and after the service.*

Children in 1st-3rd Grade and 4th-6th Grade

On Rosh Hashanah, drop-off for these two services will begin at 10:15am in Rooms 5 and 6 in the Youth Wing, with the programming scheduled to begin at 10:30am.

On Yom Kippur, drop-off will begin at 11:00am, with programming beginning at 11:15am.

Children will rejoin the main services to finish approximately the last half hour of the morning's worship with their families. A system will be in place in order to ensure that children will be able to find their families.
